- Provide a well-structured, regularly updated and easily accessible overview of all product listings for the complete global TECHNYL product portfolio and of all relevant external product norms
- Coordinate the regular update of all external listing platforms and internal databases
- Translate norms into relevant product characteristics and/or specifications and implement them into existing tools and technical documentation
